

Nevada City Winery Wins “Best Barbera Of California” Award At 2009 California State Fair For The 2007 Barbera

2007 Barbera, Sierra Foothills
Best Of California - Best Barbera
Best Of Class - Sierra Foothills
Double Gold – 98 Points

Nevada City Winery 2007 Barbera was awarded a “Best Of California” Award as the Best Barbera in California at this year’s State Fair.

In addition it earned the honor of “Best Of Class” Of The Sierra Foothills as well as a Double Gold Medal and a score of 98 points. Less than 2% of all the wines entered in the competition were awarded Double Gold Medals.

The California State Fair Commercial Wine Competition is the oldest and most prestigious wine competition in

North America. For over 150 years the California State Fair has recognized the best wines of the state. Award winners truly are the best of the best! The competition is open to all California bonded wineries.

This year more than 2,600 wines from 600 wineries entered in the competition. Sixty-eight professional wine judges awarded a total of 1,895 medals, including 43 Double Gold Medals, 220 Gold Medals, 1,028 Silver Medals and 604 Bronze Medals.

Nevada City Winery also won a Gold Medal and Best Of Class of Region for their 2007 Late Harvest Zinfandel as well as Silver Medals for Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon – Alexander Valley, and Bronze Medals for Cabernet Sauvignon - Sierra Foothills, Chardonnay, Gewurztraminer and Merlot.
